Healing Part 2

Last Week in Brief

- Mark 16:17-18—the following signs would follow those who believed and were baptized:
 - Casting out of devils
 - Tongues
 - Taking up of serpents
 - Drinking deadly things without being hurt
 - Healing of the sick
- The Mark 16 Commission contains a healing program.
- I Corinthians 1:22—The Jews require a sign.

Last Week in Brief

- Matthew 8:14-16—Last week we observed the following points:
 - All who were sick got healed. There were no excuses given for why people weren't healed.
 - Those who were healed received a total and complete restoration immediately.
- The healing of the sick and casting out of devils were done to demonstrate the nearness of the Kingdom of God:
 - Isaiah 35:3-6—Healing the sick
 - Zechariah 13:2—Casting out of devils
- Matthew 12:25-28--The casting out of unclean spirits should have been a sign to Israel that the Kingdom of God was in their midst.

Last Week in Brief

- Matthew 8:17—This is the favorite verse of those who teach that healing is in the atonement. They teach, when Christ died at Calvary He provided for the physical healing of your body right now.
 - Isaiah 53:4, I Peter 2:24—“by his stripes we are healed.”
- Christ says that Isaiah 53 was fulfilled right here in Matthew 8.
- Israel does not fully realize her atonement until the Kingdom is established. This is a perfect example of being Scriptural but not Dispensational.

Last Week in Brief

- Matthew 24:34—This generation that experienced the healing program during Christ's earthly ministry was not supposed to die.
- Acts 3:1-8—The lame man wasn't healed because he had enough faith. He didn't even know he was going to be healed. In addition, he was healed totally and completely.
- If you had to get all the sin out of your life you wouldn't even smell a blessing coming from God much less receive one.

Our Grace Healing Program

- Paul makes a distinction between you inward and outward man.
- Your body is clearly your outward man, while your soul and spirit constitute your inward man. One is material the other immaterial.
- Through the blood of Christ our inner man has been redeemed from sin. Therefore, all our sins have been forgiven.
- Our outward man is still subject to the curse of sin that is upon creation.

Our Grace Healing Program

- Romans 8:23—Believers who have been redeemed from sin through the blood of Jesus Christ are not excluded from this suffering.
- Paul tells us that we need to wait for the redemption of our body. God has given us his Spirit as the down payment and seal of the future redemption of our bodies.
- Romans 8:25—In the mean time we are instructed to patiently wait for the redemption of our bodies.
- I Corinthians 15:51-53—Our healing program occurs at the Rapture.
