
Early Mid-Acts Leaders of the 1920s: J.C. O'Hair

Historical Challenge of J.C. O'Hair

- No known chronology.
- Few works are dated.
- Oral tradition—legendary information.
- Possible tampering by those who are reprinted O'Hair's work.
- Piece together chronology based upon clues left in O'Hair writings.
- One key clue are the advertisements in the back of O'Hair pamphlets. These help establish a relative chronology.
- Understand is fluid and changing as more information comes to light



At some point subsequent to his Indy Insight in 1920 Mr. O'Hair wrote *Unscriptural Cathedrals* he which he clearly states "I have always believed and taught that the Church began at Pentecost. . ." Seems he did not immediately begin the church in Acts 13 with Paul.
